E.I. is not an honors program; it is a pull-out program that goes above and beyond the core subject instruction and enrichment your child receives in their regular classroom. In the gifted classroom (aka The E.A.G.L.E.s' Nest), I employ instructional strategies specifically designed to best meet the needs of gifted learners, not in any one subject area, but in skills like problem solving, collaboration, perseverance, creativity, and self-understanding based on the Gifted Program Standards from the National Association of Gifted Children.

I look forward to meeting new students and catching up with familiar ones at **Open House on Thursday, July 18th**! I will be available in my classroom, #75 in building 2 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, except during a lunch break from 12:00 - 1:00 pm.
