

Principal's Message

Dear EDUPRIZE Parent,

We are in full swing of all learning and it is looking great! Teachers and students are working hard on both academic and social learning and how those areas relate to and with each other! The classroom community is blossoming, creating a caring community of learners.

Each year students are given an opportunity to extend their learning with four field experiences, two on campus and two off campus. All field experiences are aligned with our cottage themes and are incredible opportunities to make connections between what is being learned to real life. As a school, families are asked to pay a LIFE Fund each year to go toward the cost of these field experiences. The LIFE Fund charge is \$75 per student per year. The LIFE Fund does not cover all the costs of all four field experiences per year, but it does offset expenses for the bus and some of the cost of the admission fees. All field trips are carefully selected and planned to give students the best experience.

The LIFE Fund payment is due no later than September 1, 2024. Students who do not pay the LIFE Fund by the deadline will not be able to participate in the school-sponsored field trips. Students who don't attend the trip will be given an alternative lesson for the day.

You can use your ECA Tax donation to make your LIFE Fund payment, which is wonderful, because you will get it all back, dollar for dollar, at tax time.

Please make sure your child has the LIFE Fund paid so s/he will not miss out on the wonderful trips we have planned! Some extra observations these last few weeks that need changes:

- There will be a short wait at carpool pickup IF everyone follows their assigned lane and time. Please only come 5
 minutes before your scheduled release, it will allow for students to be picked up during the correct release and not back
 the lanes up.
- When driving on the main roads, please follow the law which is NO passing and driving 15 mph in the school zone.
- In the carpool lanes, please do not be on your cell phones and please drive slowly. Safety is of utmost importance!
- There is no drop-off or pick-up of students in the parking lot. Use the designated carpool lanes for ALL drop-off and pick-up. If you are unsure of your lane, please call us.
- We are needing you as Volunteers!! Please check with teachers and see how YOU can help in the classroom.



(SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING)

Dear EDUPRIZE families,

One of the key behavior skills that school demands of students is the ability to follow directions. This can be hard for some kids - especially those who may have never been in a school setting before. <u>Understood.org</u> is a FANTASTIC resource with quick articles of strategies that grown-ups can use to help kids be better able to do lots of things, including following directions.



- Gain your child's attention
- Minimize distractions
- Speak quietly
- Use "wait time" allow 3 to 7 seconds for children to process what you are saying
- Check for understanding
- Tell, don't ask when you ask a question like, "Will you set the table, please?" this can make kids think they have a choice. Instead, say, "Set the table, please."
- Give one instruction at a time
- Number your directions
- Be precise in your language
- Use visuals

Health Office Updates

IMPORTANT HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION

As illness or health situations occur throughout the school year, it may be necessary for medication to be administered at school. All prescribed AND over the counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc.) will need to be checked into the Health Office, along with a <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form which requires a doctor's signature. These forms can be found on our website <u>www.eduprizeschools.net</u> under the Parent & Student Resources>Health Office Forms, or you can just click on any of the links provided in light blue.

- <u>HEALTH ACTION PLAN</u>: Please be aware that children who have asthma, diabetes, or seizures will need an action plan provided by their health care provider, ALONG with the signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form .
- <u>ASTHMA</u>: If your child has asthma, an asthma action plan will need to be provided by your doctor ALONG with a signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form .
- <u>ALLERGIES</u>: Allergies that require an EpiPen will need an <u>Anaphylaxis Management Packet</u> filled out and signed by a doctor along with the <u>Prescription and Non-prescription</u> <u>Medication Consent</u> form .
- <u>MEDICATION</u>: As a reminder, ALL medications need to be checked in at the Health Office. Students are not allowed to carry any medication in their backpack unless the parent and Dr have signed a self carry medication consent in addition to the medication consent form. A <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form will also need to be filled out for any medications, prescription or non prescription.

We cannot accept ANY medications without these forms. Any questions can be directed to the Health Office staff at (480) 813-9537 option 7
